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EXPLANATION OF FEES

“Refraction” is the measurement of the lens power necessary to prescribe glasses, contact lenses, and determine surgical necessity. Most medical insurance plans, including Medicare, do not cover this service. With each annual visit, it is necessary to take certain measurements of the eye, including refraction, in order to properly prescribe glasses, contact lenses or discuss surgical options. The refraction may be performed at subsequent visits if there has been a change in your vision or by physician request.

If you have a separate vision plan, it may cover routine or annual eye examinations, contact lens fittings and/or glasses. **We do NOT currently file with any vision plans.** We **do** file all medical insurances assuming we are a participating provider. Upon request, we will gladly give you a receipt of payment for your refraction and/or contact lens services to submit to your vision insurance provider.
